 to be buried in the Churchyard of Witley aforesaide. Item
 I will devise and bequeath unto Johane my wife and to his
 executives standinge and beinge in Witley aforesaide. To have
 and to hold from and after my decease for and duringe
 the terme of five naturall life from hence next ensuinge.
~~the~~ my will and meaninge is that after the decease of Johane
 my wife, my saide house and landes shall remayne unto
 her or her children some and to his joint forever more.
 Woodier shal paye some fye pounds to be paid unto her or his
 two years next after my saide decease. All my good and
 chattels whatsoever, I do give and bequeath unto Johane
 my wife duringe the tyme of her livinge. I make revocable
 my last will and Testament and to be void all
 debts as I now owe. Also I constitute and appointe
 Lawrence Stronge of Witley and John Mylles of
 Croydon my brother in lawe to be the executors of my
 last will, and I do give unto either of them my power
 over and above any charge or fee may be at in lawe or
 otherwise touchinge this my will, to see the same
 fulfilled, accordinge to the true meaninge thereof. And thus
 I have said herein upon me. Witness my hande
 Lawrence Stronge and John Mylles.
