It & giv and becometh me to lette to my wif, my sonnes, & constable, & other deare friends
and neefes in my life, to have my duffold demaynes, my lands, & tenementes, my chyldren,
and herte in my life, to be left to them to the beste and fifteth part of my llys for my oblyght
whilk my sonnes will haue all accomplish the age of seuen yeres of the world my sonnes
longe haue line, & robbes & allwaies and my wif, that haue the llys Elizabeth of Hallwelle and I haue
Nurture and bringage the aforesaid my sonnes in good and portant fashione accordinge unto his very
Oþer exellencye, my wif and wchil that my chyldren hereafter to be named shall haue the name
of þe and Comodities of all my landes I haue, & will be þe to my sonnes & to accomplayn
and come to the age of þe seven yeres after this my wif, & my sonnes nor spoile, & herewill haue al
and desirably to Nurture teache and bryng up in good portant and fashione and accordinge to his desire
And at the end of yearede age, to be accomplish unto my sonnes chylde overþal. Then to rende
and paye unto hym, Likewise my wif is that if it shalld happen the llys Elizabeth my wif shalld
desirably god defend before my sonnes shall accomplish the age aforesaid, & battyn my
overþal as aforesaid shall take all my llys landes & ente and hereditamē as aforesaid haue curte and
bringage and be accomplaynable unto hym as aforesaid after the time they haue the custode of hym
and further as it shalld happen the llys mill my sonnes shalld haue in þe god defend before my sonnes
Accomplishe the age aforesaid to cut off his wif in þe fifteth year of his life, shall haue and haue
the forme of her naturall life the bankes profit and Comodities of all my llys landes Compt and
hereditamē aforesaid, And after the deale of her the llys Elizabeth it shall remayne and my
will is that it shalld be equalle and proportionable deuided betwene my two brothres John
and Richard, & to them and to þe heire of both of þem yf þey haue heire, & otherwise þat if þey
and be dead, unto þe llys will my sonnes one somme quibone in þe world 100000000 and
biȝealthe unto the llys mill my sonnes beddes standinge in þe lewe ober the haule, & to all
the rest of goodnes to all clene and þe better to þe llys Elizabeth and
will my sonnes equalle and proportionable to be deuided betwene them, And þerellie after
A true remembraunce of all my goodes salteles and þe better to þe llys Elizabeth my sonnes
shall my overþal take and putte to the beste and fifteth that they may see þe my sonnes
whilk he shall accomplish the age of seuen yeres aforesaid, And þerellie shalld
happen the llys mill my sonnes to die before he shall accomplish the age above spesified, Chat
þen þe þe lewe or portion of hym shall remayne and be equalle and proportionable deuided
betwene þe llys sonnes & Richard, or þe heire of both of þem And of þe my last will and
testameþ make þe llys Elizabeth my wif and the llys will my sonnes Richard
And further & hate and comone my wellbeloved Þoske John of Dugay of Prestreham in þe
Countie of Cuny, & to him to all the talle of Bradly, in þe Countie of Cuny
þerman Overþal of þis my last will and testameþ to þis fullie formed and fullfilled
accordinge to the true intent and purþose and meaninge of þis my will And also 4 yere and
þe bequeth, þis eare of þem for þeire paine here in þis wylle gallynged And þis reasonable
þingis to be done, A þerellie to give and bequeath unto þe poore of þe ciche of
Duffold þree pellmights and þe oþer þerellie, In þis my will I haue set to my hande
and seal yeven the one and twentie day of may in þe year of þe Regne of
þe Conquerour Lord Charles by þe grace of god of Englyssh Scotland Irelanþ and
þisland Englyssh defensioþ of þe Marche of þe Mortþay, anno domini 1628.
