**Transcriber's notes on text and suggestions about parcel name etymologies:**

- (2) Number, probably 3, overwritten with extra-thick 2

- (4) (5) Intermittent dashed lines up to right-hand side of column
- (6) Two dashed lines

**204 High Field Close:** from ME *clōs* 'small, enclosed piece of land'; 'a small, enclosed, high field'

**205 Jacley:** uncertain, possibly commemorating a person's name

**207 Heath Field:** from OE *hæth* 'heather', a tract of uncultivated land'; 'heathy open land'

**208 Little Vinzer:** from ME *vine*, *Vinzerd*, 'vine', 'vineyard', but also 'land growing with creepers'

**210/212 & 215: Bevil Common Downs:** possibly from OF *baivel*, '*sloping from the horizontal or vertical*'; 'sloping common downs'

**214 Furze Field:** from OE *fyr*s, 'gorse'; *fyr*sen, '*growing with gorse*'; 'open land of gorse'
